A planning application for the demolition of all buildings on the site of Hatton Lane Farm, and for the construction of a large house with outbuildings was submitted to Warrington Borough Council. Originally Planning Permission for the conversion of the existing barns to

The Parish Council did not make any comment to Warrington Borough Council on the application which is likely to be decided later this year.
