Increase of Traffic Through the Village

The Parish Council have received several complaints and concerns from residents due to the increase of traffic through the village, due to the roadworks on the A56. We have been in contact with the police and requested Tru Cam speed enforcement in the area over the coming months. We have also raised our concerns with Cllr Laura Booth, who has agreed to take this issue up with WBC as a matter of urgency. It is hoped that the Highways Department will be able to conduct some traffic surveys to evidence the increase in traffic
